

The Shona Project continues to play its part in ensuring our future women leaders have the skills, confidence and knowledge to have a real-world impact."



Overview

- At present, we have 4 facilitators who deliver our school workshops to schools all over Ireland.
- We offer two different types of interactive workshops which are 1.5 hours long and can cater for up to 100 students per group.
- Our kindness workshop discusses topics such as influence, kindness and the challenges faced by young people.
- Our **Mindset workshop** discusses topics such as using our voice, positive mindset and dealing with stress and/or anxiety.

Key Achievements In 2023

- 173 workshops delivered.
- 11,152 girls reached.
- 95 schools visited in almost every county in Ireland.
- Consistently fully booked 3 to 4 months in advance.

AMBASSADOR PROGRAMMES

Overview

- Our **Junior Ambassador Programme** was created in 2022. We now have over **130** Junior Ambassadors in schools all over Ireland.
- Our Ambassadors are leaders who drive the Shona Message of kindness, positivity, inclusion and resilience within their schools.
- They meet on a **monthly basis** for discussion around topics from leadership to resilience.
- We have a **Senior Ambassador programme** which offers personal development for young adults through monthly online sessions and two annual in-person meet ups. Our **27 participants** are led by accomplished women and work in small groups to set and achieve goals related to education and careers. The programme also includes expert talks, networking, and peer support, with an alumni network launching in 2025/26.
- We also host **'Everything club'** each month. This is open to all of our Ambassadors



AMBASSADOR PROGRAMMES

Key Achievements

- **During 2024** we have increased our Junior Ambassador numbers by 30% from 100 to 130.
- We launched our New Senior Ambassador
 Programme in September and currently
 have 27 participants in the programme.
- We held our annual Junior Ambassador summit in March which was attended by 85 guests and themed around making International Women's Day.
- In 2024 our Ambassadors starred in IMAGE Magazine, spoke at Shine Fesitval and had their writing published in the Cork Echo Magazine.

Overview

- A powerful and inspiring multi-awardwinning event that takes place each year in celebration of International Day of the Girl.
- 2024 saw our **biggest** Shine Festival yet.
- **Shine Online** is a supported suite of videos created to act as a classroom resource for teachers and is available the whole year through completely **free of charge**.
- Shine Festival allows for The Shona Project to create long-standing and meaningful relationships with corporates.





Key Achievements

- **2,500 teenage girls** attended Shine Festival 2024 resulting in the biggest live event ever run by TSP.
- 36 schools attended from a large range of counties in Ireland.
- 67.7% of the teenage girls who attended stated that Shine Festival 2024 has strengthened their values, increased their ability to understand social issues and inspired them to speak up more.
- 100% of the teachers stated they would consider returning to Shine Festival next year with their students.
- Approximately 90.5% of all respondents (teachers, students and volunteer) stated they were either happy or very happy with the range and diversity of speakers.
- 82.25% of students noted that they strongly agreed or agreed that having attended Shine Festival, they are more aware of the importance of their own selfection esteem and self-worth.

SURVIVAL KIT HANDBOOKS

Overview

- Our handbooks are distributed to 1st year girls in hundreds of schools across Ireland every year.
- The handbook is like a little bestie or big sister.
- The beautifully illustrated Handbook for Girls is written for girls by girls. Packed with content including making new friends, mental health, staying positive, the online world, and ways to take care of yourself.
- Since 2019, 130,000 free copies have been handed out to teenage girls across Ireland.

Key Achievements

- 35,000 free copies have been distributed to girls all over Ireland.
- 252 schools engaged through the 2024 edition.
- Our 2024 handbook also offered The Shona Project the perfect opportunity to further develop relationships with partner organisations. Once again, this year's main partner was Custodian, who kindly printed and delivered the handbooks pro bono

- The 2024/25 academic year sees the pilot of The Shona Project National Mentoring
 Programme.
- This programme will **pair girls aged 16–18** with professional women, with whom they will build a mentoring relationship over the course of the school year.
- These girls will be nominated by schools in The Shona Project's networks, with an initial focus on targeting girls who might otherwise not have access to this type of opportunity.
- The pilot year sees **26 pairs**, which are made up of girls from 5 schools across the country and mentors from 6 parter organisations.

Additional Information

- The Mentorship Programme aims to provide a safe space for girls to receive one-on-one support, resulting in:
 - Increased understanding of career options, journeys, and experiences of women in the workplace
 - Increased career aspirations and an expanded network of career support
 - Increased confidence to find and implement solutions



Case Study: Katie & Emma



For year 1 of the programme, 6th-year student Katie has been paired with mentor Emma, who works at Allianz, a founding corporate partner of the programme.

The pair met in-person at the 2024/25 programme launch at Allianz HQ in Dublin, and hit it off straight away!


Since meeting in September, the pair have already taken great steps:

- They have completed their first **online mentorship sessions**, which included setting goals for the year;
- Katie has now completed the first of three TSP workshop sessions with our team;
- Inspired by Katie's ambition to pursue a career in law, Emma
 has gone above and beyond in arranging a trip for Katie to a
 Courthouse (safeguarding permissions for this meet
 handled by TSP);
- After writing an article for her school paper on The Shona
 Project, Katie was invited to speak on Ireland AM alongside
 TSP founder Tammy. She spoke of the difficulties of being a
 young woman at school today, the confidence that her
 mentor has already given her, her excitement about the
 opportunities afforded her by the programme, and gave a
 glowing shoutout to her mentor Emma and her employer
 Allianz.
